How could you ever know if you're being a good neighbor? Can you measure it?

Jesus prioritized loving our neighbor, and even said that all the law hangs on the two commands: Love God and Love your neighbor. Both could be difficult to measure, unless we take the Word of God and use it as the standard.

Are you treating others the way you'd like to be treated? Matthew 7:12

Do you love them as you love yourself? Romans 13:9

Do you prioritize other's needs as your own? Philippians 2:3-4

Does God's love flow out of you toward others? I John 3:17

Do you treat everyone this way even if he is your enemy? Matthew 5:43-47

Do you love the strangers among us? Deuteronomy 10:19

The Good Samaritan, the classic example of being a good neighbor, had compassion and showed it in the action he took (Luke 10). He checked all the boxes above by his actions, even going the extra mile by offering to return and pay for additional needs the man might have (Matthew 5:41).

If you are struggling to bear the fruit of LOVE toward your neighbor, who might be your friend, a stranger, or even an enemy, remember that ABIDING in Christ (John 15) brings the transformation and gives you the power to effectively produce all spiritual fruit.
