

Gathering to worship in person at Calvary - Beginning June 28, 2020

Basics:

TWO Services - 9:00am & 11:00am

Both services will have similar worship and sermon content.

Service attendance will be limited to 50 for now.

Wear a face mask/covering as you enter the building. You may remove the mask once you are settled. This is for all individuals age 2 and up.

Seating will be spaced out to allow for social distancing.

If you don't feel good, stay home.

Sunday's Focus is on large gatherings. All other Sunday morning activity is on hold for now. The Worship Services at Calvary and Luz de Betel are the only meetings on Sunday mornings.

Small groups will continue to meet throughout the week for additional fellowship, discipleship and prayer.

Do I have to come back to Sunday Services?

We'd absolutely love to see you! But if you're just not ready yet—for any reason—feel free to stay home. The Services will be LIVE Streamed on YouTube as a new regular reality at Calvary.

What is happening for the Kingdom Kids?

Nursery and Kids classrooms will not be open at this time.

Families are encouraged to bring their children to the SECOND (11:00am) service which will have extra content just for them.

How early can I come? How late can I stay?

The doors will open at 8:30 for the first service.

The doors will open at 10:45 for the second service.

We encourage folks to fellowship briefly and then exit the first service to allow for a quick wipe down of the building before the second service. Conversations may continue outside as long as the entrance to the building and the parking lot do not become congested.

What do I need to do before I come back?

Now and always:

Pray. Prepare yourself to meet with God and his people. The number one benefit of gathering is NOT to hear from the pastor. It isn't even for you to simply meet with God. You can hear the pastor online. You can (and should be!) meeting with God on a daily basis. The BEST reason to come to church is to MEET GOD with OTHERS WHO SHARE your FAITH! Prepare to share something of your story and to be blessed as others share. Prepare to love your brothers and sisters in the Lord as we are able to see each other in person again.

Each Sunday:

Be on time. For this season especially, we are constricted on the time for service to accommodate everyone. We'll start on time and end in a timely way to accommodate the second service.

Expect a "touch-less" environment.

Handshakes and hugs will not be the norm.

Bulletins will be electronic.

Doors will be propped open.

No Coffee or Donuts will be served at this time.

Communion will look different.

First Service Advantages

The building will have been more thoroughly cleaned. If you are older or have a reason to be medically concerned, please plan to attend at 9:00am.

Second Service Advantages

A portion of the 11:00 service will be planned specifically for our children. Families with children are encouraged to attend this service.
